### **Lectures & Hospital Rotations**

Participants will attend several lectures where they will receive important information about the Mexican healthcare system before they rotate in the hospitals.

The type of rotation will be based on the hospital's needs and will be informed to the students prior to their arrival.

Students will be assigned to a physician in each hospital, and this person will be in charge of the whole rotation of the students

#### **Reflection Sessions**

Participants will be assigned to an academic advisor and will attend reflection sessions where they will be able to share their experience with others participants.

An academic advisor will moderate the session and will also answer any type of questions that students might have after the rotations.
