Practicum

Students will attend lectures regarding relevant topics as well as completing social service in shelters, NGO's and underprivileged communities.

Participants will actively participate in daily life activities of their chosen community/ NGO's such as taking care of children or people with special needs or working in a day care or nursing home.

One of the main objectives of the program is to give international students a complete overview of Mexican society, such as the role of traditions, family religion, poverty, and gender issues.

Reflection Sessions

Participants will be assigned an academic advisor and will attend and moderate reflection sessions where they will be able to share their experiences with other participants, also he/she will answer any questions that students might have after each practicum experience.
