## Practicum

Participants will be enrolled in a teaching course, where a Mexican professor will prepare the student to teach in a local school.

They will be able to prepare lesson plans, learn techniques to have a good control over the class and other main topics that a professor in Mexico should be aware of.

Participants will be in charge of a class or will assist a professor during the class or afterwards for tutorials. Schools are located in different locations around Puebla and Cholula and most of them are public elementary schools.

## Reflection Sessions

Participants will be assigned to an academic advisor and will attend and moderate reflection sessions where students will share their experience with other participants, and also he/she will answer any questions that students might have after each practicum experience.
